## Admissions

- Admission is granted purely on merit basis, regardless of class, caste, creed or community.
- Registration for admission test is essential. Application form for registration is available at the School Reception against a prescribed fee.
- Duly completed form is to be submitted to the office by the due date. Admissions are taken only in Nursery to Std. IX & Std. XI and as per vacancies available in other classes.
- Students coming from schools affiliated to other Boards & not CBSE will have to get their Migration Certificate (M.C.) for admission in class XI only.
- Unless the T.C. is produced, admission will be treated as provisional. In case, the relevant documents are not submitted within a month from the date of admission, then it will stand cancelled. At the time of admission in Std. I, the student must have completed 6 years of age.
- The school does not allow any private tuition from its staff for entrance tests. It is, therefore, advised that no staff member be approached for such work.
- The Management/Principal reserves the right to accept or reject any application for admission/re-admission without assigning any reason.

## Classes I - XII

#### Classes I & II

Children at this level are at a formative stage where the pace of learning and personality development are quite fast. Evaluation at this stage is therefore, formative in nature with adequate emphasis on both continuity and comprehensiveness. Students are not evaluated through formal examination system, instead by using observations and oral techniques on the basis of their participation in Classroom Activities and Worksheets.

#### Classes III to V

In these classes, there is a slight shift in evaluation which then becomes formal. Students know when they are tested with continued observation, oral and written techniques.

Standard X is a terminal stage in the 10+2 scheme of education followed by the School. Hence, admission to class XI in the School shall be a fresh admission.

This admission shall be subject to screening of all the students and availability of seats in the class and subject combination.

Regularity in attendance, consistent academic performance as well as good conduct and behaviour is essential throughout the year.

The School has eligibility norms for admission to Science, Commerce and Humanities Streams in class XI. Students securing 70% and above in aggregate in Std. X will be admitted in Science Stream and students scoring aggregate percentage ranging between 60% to 69% will be admitted in Commerce Stream. For admission to Humanities Stream, new students must have scored at least 50% marks in aggregate.

## Attendance

Students should have 75% attendance in a year compulsorily to make them eligible to appear in the final examination.

Leave application must be submitted on the same day. More than two day's sick leave must be accompanied by a Medical Certificate. Continuous absence from School for 5 days will lead to cancellation of admission. Re-admission in such cases will be discretionary. An amount of Rs 1000/- will have to be paid (besides the absence fine) in case readmission is allowed.

The students should avoid coming late to school. It is compulsory for all the students to attend Morning Assembly. The defaulters will be marked absent.

No student can leave the School premises during school hours without the permission of the Principal.

# Rules for payment of fee

- Fee is to be deposited within first 15 days of every quarter at the School Fee Counter. For this purpose, Special triplicate fee deposit slips should be obtained by the parents from the School Accounts Office.
- If the fee is not paid by due date, a surcharge of Rs. 10/- will be levied for each day of delay including holidays. If the fee is not paid by 15th of the following month, the student's name will be struck off the rolls without any notice. Re-admission, if granted, will be on payment of the Re-admission fee of Rs. 1500/.
- 3 The School tuition fee is to be paid in quarterly modes in cheque / cash / online by 15th of the specified month i.e. April, July, October and January.
- 4 Before the commencement of Half Yearly (SA-I) and Final Examination (SA-2), all dues have to be cleared off by the specified dates.
- 5 Fee once deposited will not be refundable.





# General Rules and Regulations

- The students should reach the school only ten minutes before the morning bell is rung.
- School uniform is to be worn on all school days.
- Students who come late will not be allowed to enter the school premises. School gates will be closed for such students.
- Students should be careful to keep their classrooms and the school premises clean and tidy.
- Students are not allowed to keep / wear costly items or bring to school any kind of valuables like calculator, mobile phone, camera, precious stones or any item of jewellery like chains, rings etc. The school will not be responsible for loss of any such articles.
- Students should not carry any prohibited eatables: Pan Masala, Gutkha or any kind of drink to school.
- Irregular attendance, neglect of home work, disobedience and disrespect towards teachers or any other reprehensible behaviour may entail dismissal from the school.
- Cycles, scooters, motor-cycles, etc must be locked and kept at the specified stand only. Students keeping their vehicles unlocked will be fined and school will not be responsible if they are lost.
- No collection for any purpose whatsoever shall be made in the School without the prior permission of the Principal.
- Care must be taken of all school property and no student should scratch or spoil the desks or chairs or damage any school furniture, write or draw anything on the walls or in any way damage things belonging to others. Any damage done will be made good by the concerned student(s) together with a fine imposed on him/her/them for such an offence. Such offence may entail expulsion from the School also.
- Firing crackers or splashing colors in School premises is strictly forbidden. Non-compliance of these instructions will result in expulsion from the School.
- Management shall have the power to add or amend the rules any time.

## Medical examination

Regular medical examinations are arranged by the School and a health checkup record is maintained and sent to parents.



## Withdrawal

The intended withdrawal of a student from the school must be communicated to the Principal in writing at least one calendar month [thirty days] in advance: otherwise one month's fee will be charged.

The School reserves the right to require the parents to withdraw their child if the progress in studies is unsatisfactory or irregular attendance or conduct harmful to other students or fee not paid in advance or if there are other reasons. Honesty, cleanliness, good manners and loyalty are expected of each student. Anyone not conforming to the school's ideals in these matters may be asked to leave. Immortality, grave insubordination, contempt of authority or wilful damage to School property are always reasons for dismissal. A student who fails the second time in the School will not be allowed to continue.

## Parents' Role

For effective education, it is necessary that the School receives full co-operation from the parents

- Guidance, encouragement and opportunity should be constantly provided for mental growth even at home.
- Parents are not allowed to interfere with the school administration in any way. In case of any problem, they can discuss the same with the Principal.
- Parents/Guardians are expected to co-operate in enforcing regularity and discipline by seeing that the children prepare their lessons and do their home work. The medium of instruction being English in the School, students should be encouraged to converse in English at home also.
- To improve expression and fluency in English, it is compulsory for students to speak only in English in school and outside the campus.
- Parents/Guardians are particularly requested to sign the Principal's / Teacher's remarks in the Scholar's Diary after reading them. The School disclaims all responsibility if the remarks are not signed.
- Parents/Guardians or other persons are not permitted to see the student or teacher during School hours without prior permission of the Principal. They will, however, not visit their wards or teachers in the class/staff room under any circumstances. In case of any complaint about the School, parents are requested to contact the Principal and not the class teacher. Criticism of the School or teachers in the presence of students should be avoided, as it adversely affects discipline.
- The Principal has full authority to issue Transfer Certificate to a student who is found violating School rules or even if parents indulge in activities detrimental to the smooth functioning of the School. Parents must acknowledge all school circulars, teachers's notes promptly and comply with the instructions contained in the these circulars and notes.
- They must report immediately to School office about any change of address or mobile numbers, etc. on the prescribed form.

## Parent - Teacher Meet

Parent-Teacher Meets are arranged on every Third Saturday and before the Examinations. These must be compulsorily attended in the general interest of the child. The Progress Card is issued to the Parents / Guardians only personally in such meets. The students must accompany their parents / guardians to the Parent-Teacher-Meet in proper School Uniform.
